

Are you registered to vote in the state of Kentucky?



How would you rate the job Matt Bevin has been doing as Governor? Do you approve or disapprove of the job he is doing?



How would you rate the job Donald Trump has been doing as President? Do you approve or disapprove of the job he is doing?







Which of the following issues do you believe is the most important: economy and job growth, education, morality issues, healthcare, illegal immigration or protecting 2nd Amendment rights?







Should school administrators be required to notify parents if their child indicates he or she has gender dysphoria or otherwise struggles with gender identity?





Who should have the ultimate authority in decisions regarding a child's upbringing, education, and medical care: the parents, or the State?





Should people who identify themselves as transgender be allowed to use public bathrooms, locker rooms, and showers that correspond to their self-identified gender?





Should the State allow private faith-based adoption and foster care agencies to operate according to their religious beliefs and place children only in homes with both a mother and a father?





Should parents have the right to attempt experimental medical treatments, without government interference, that might save their terminally ill children?







Thinking about how you get your news, which of the following would you say you prefer most for getting news?



Do you consider yourself to be Very Conservative, Somewhat Conservative, Moderate, Somewhat Liberal or Very Liberal?






What is your gender?






