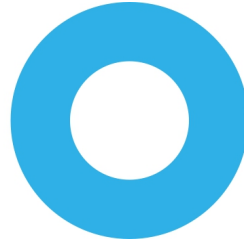

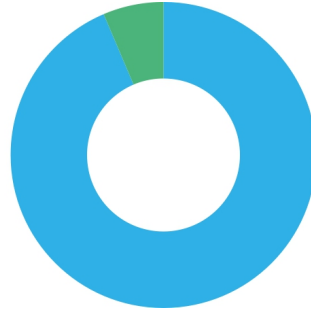

■ Very likely ■ Somewhat likely

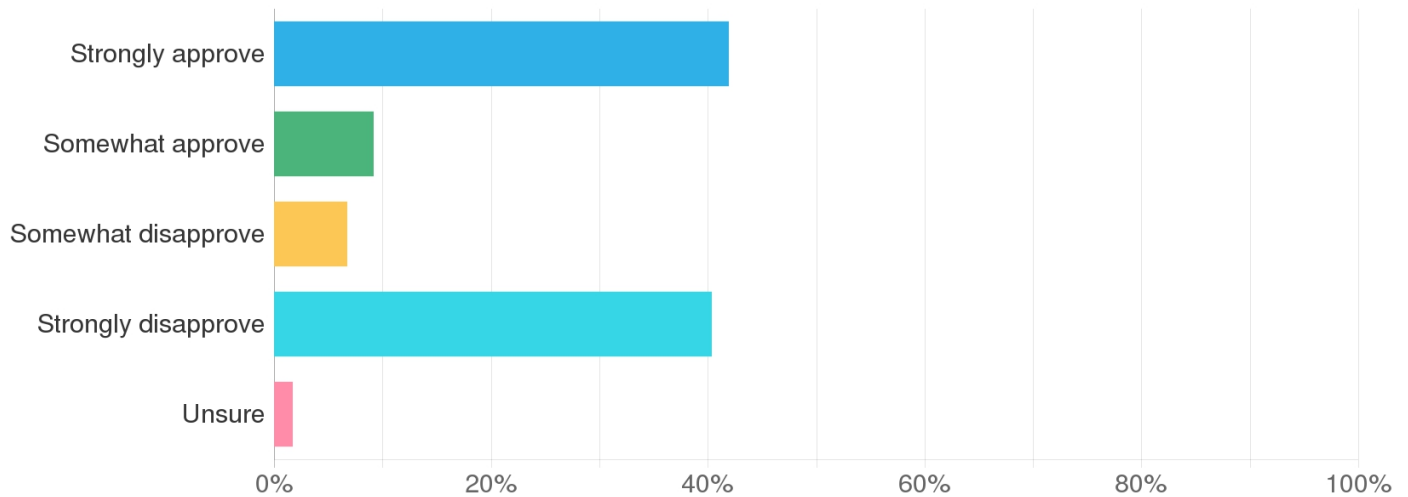

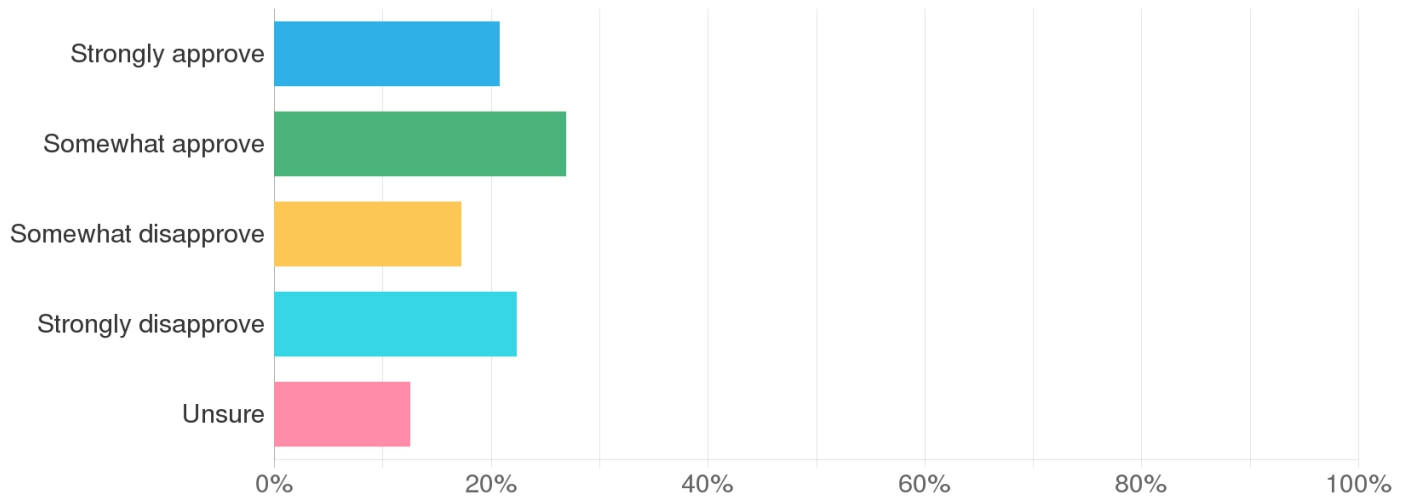

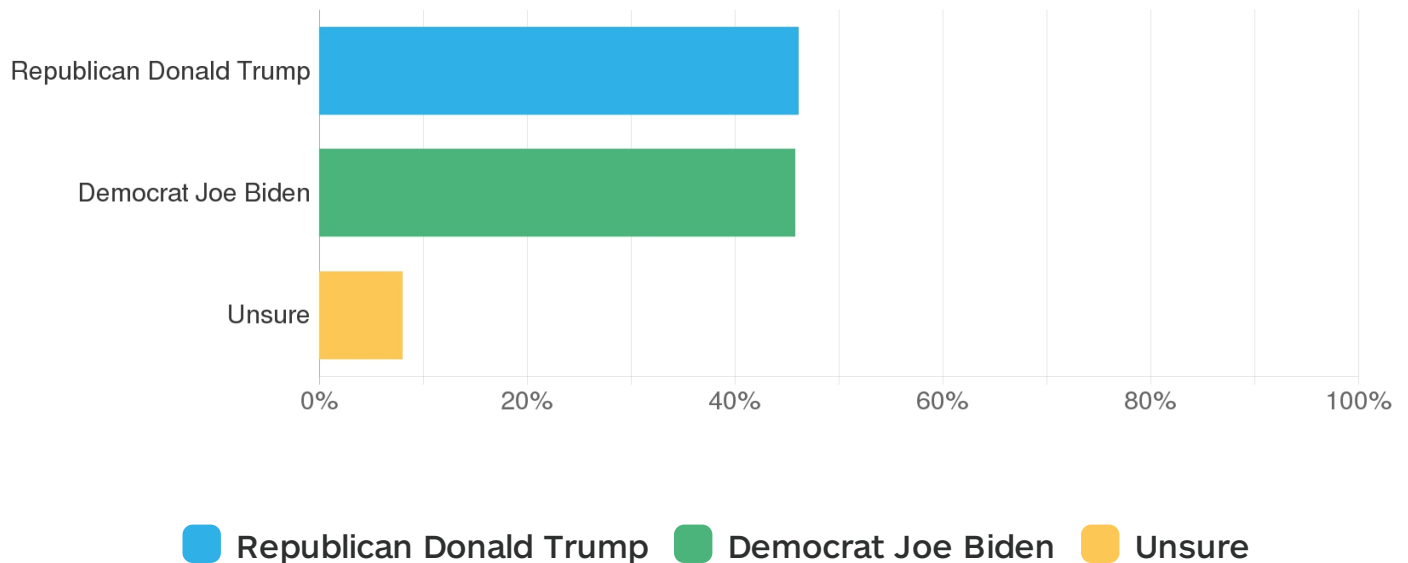

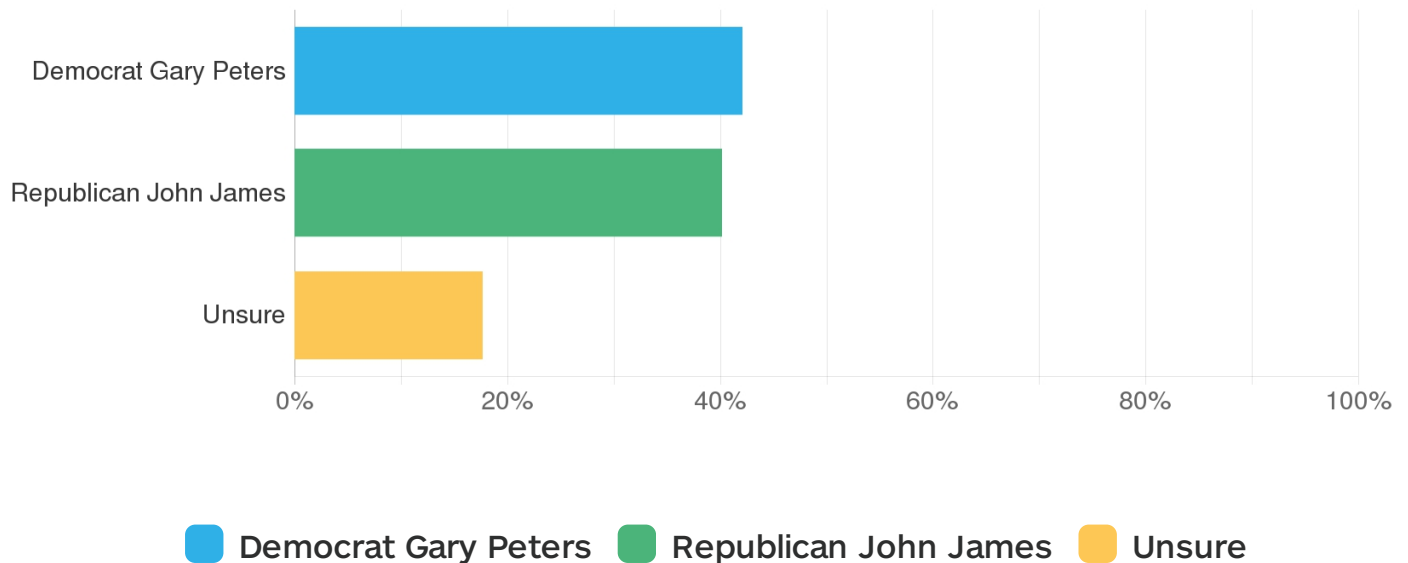

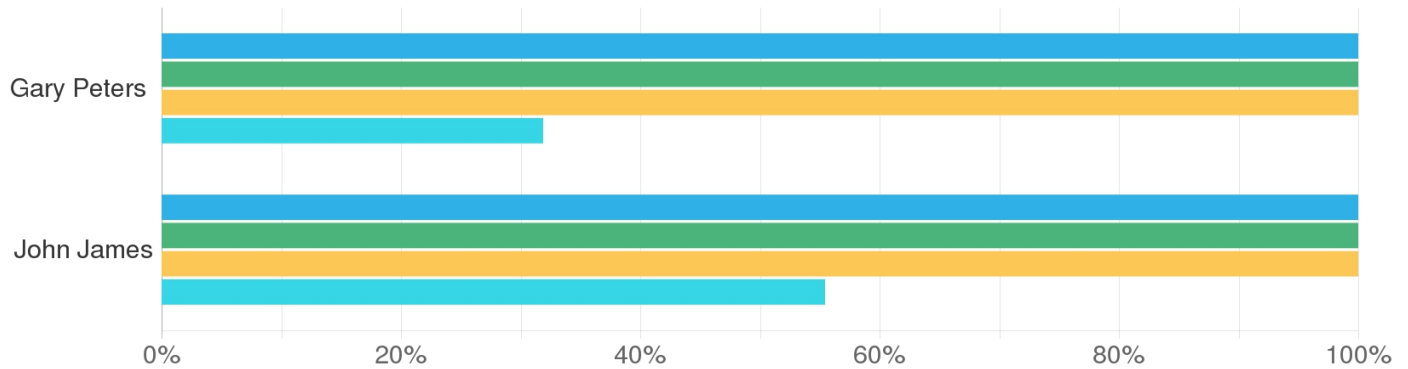

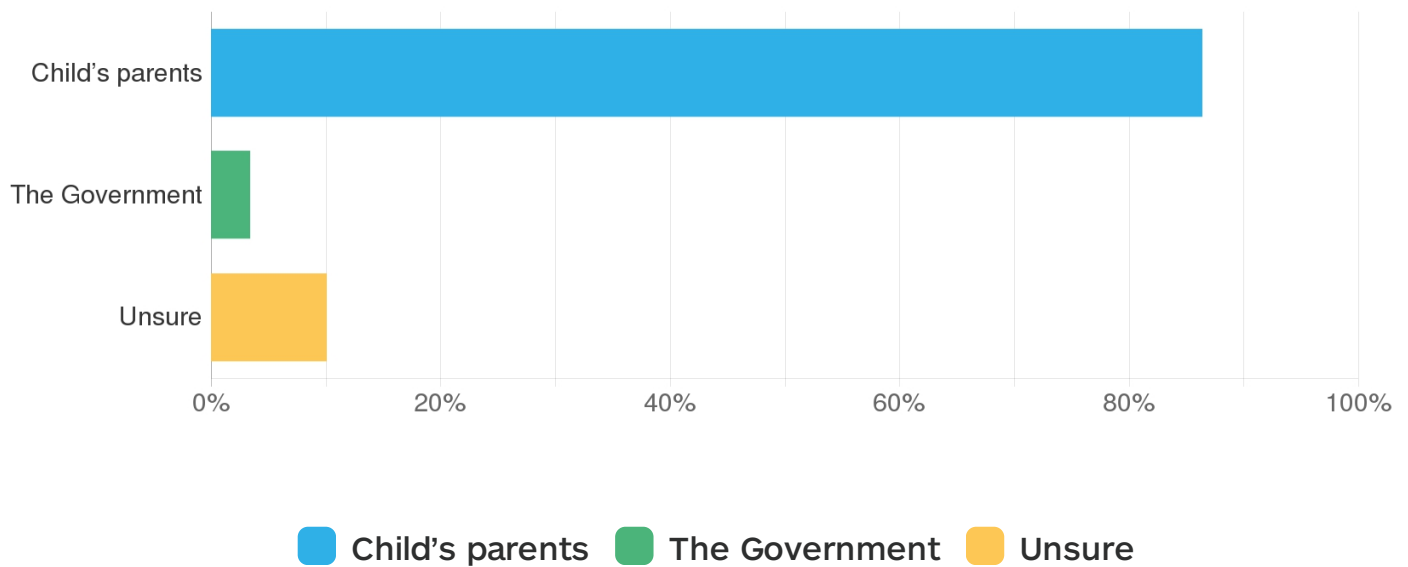

When it comes to making tough choices about a child's health care, who should have ultimate decision-making authority? The child's parents or the government?



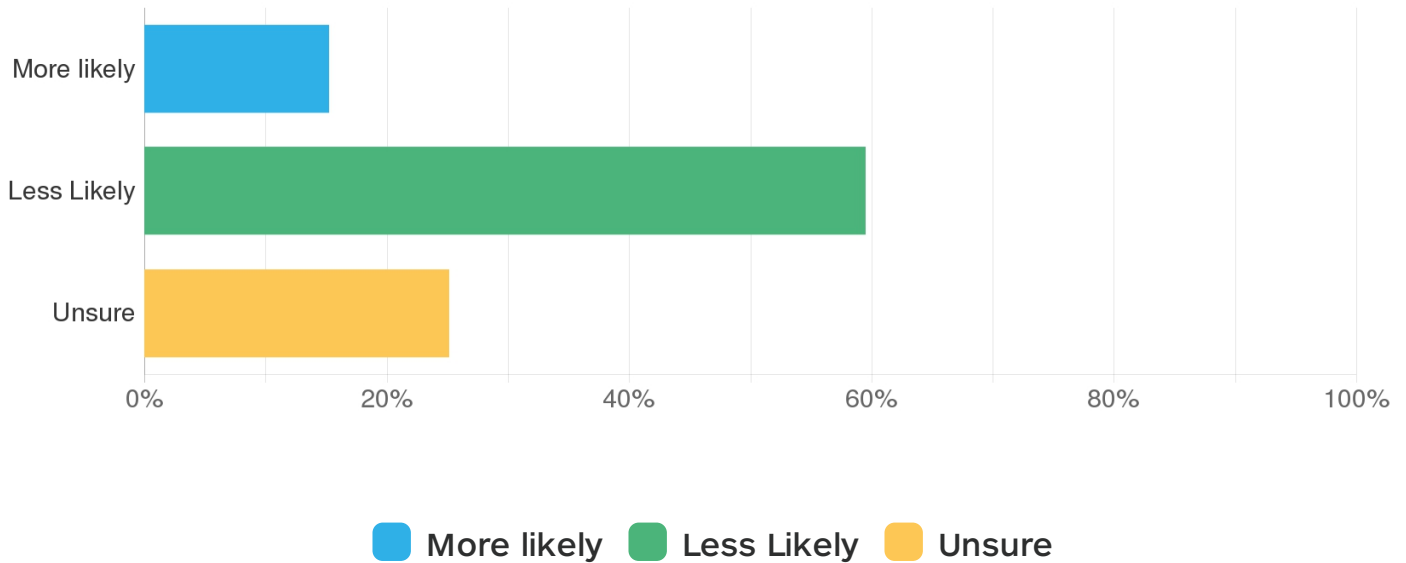

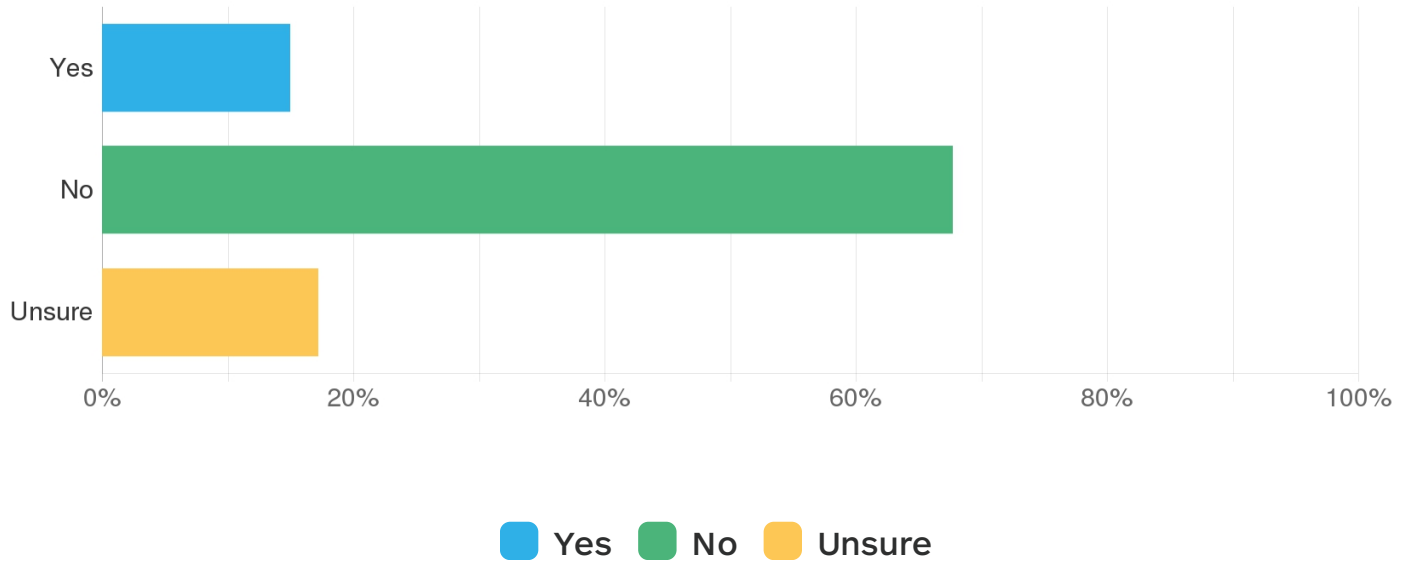

Should children who say they identify with a different gender than their birth sex be allowed to undergo physical sex change surgeries or gender transition treatments while they are still under the age of 18?



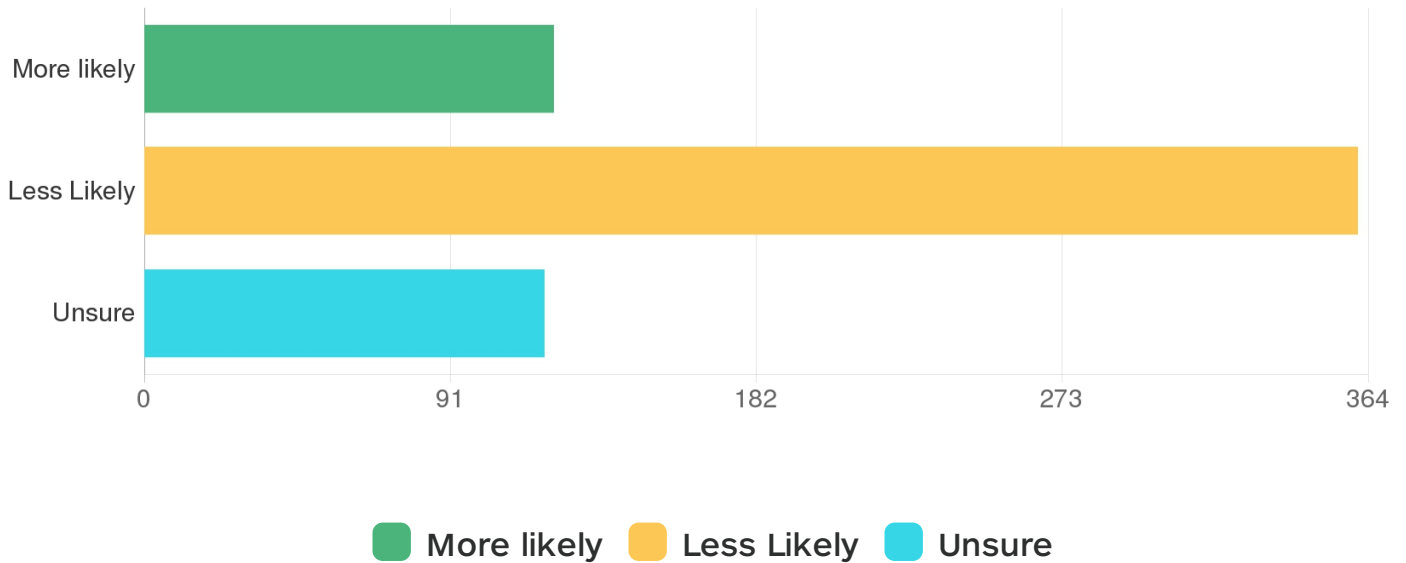

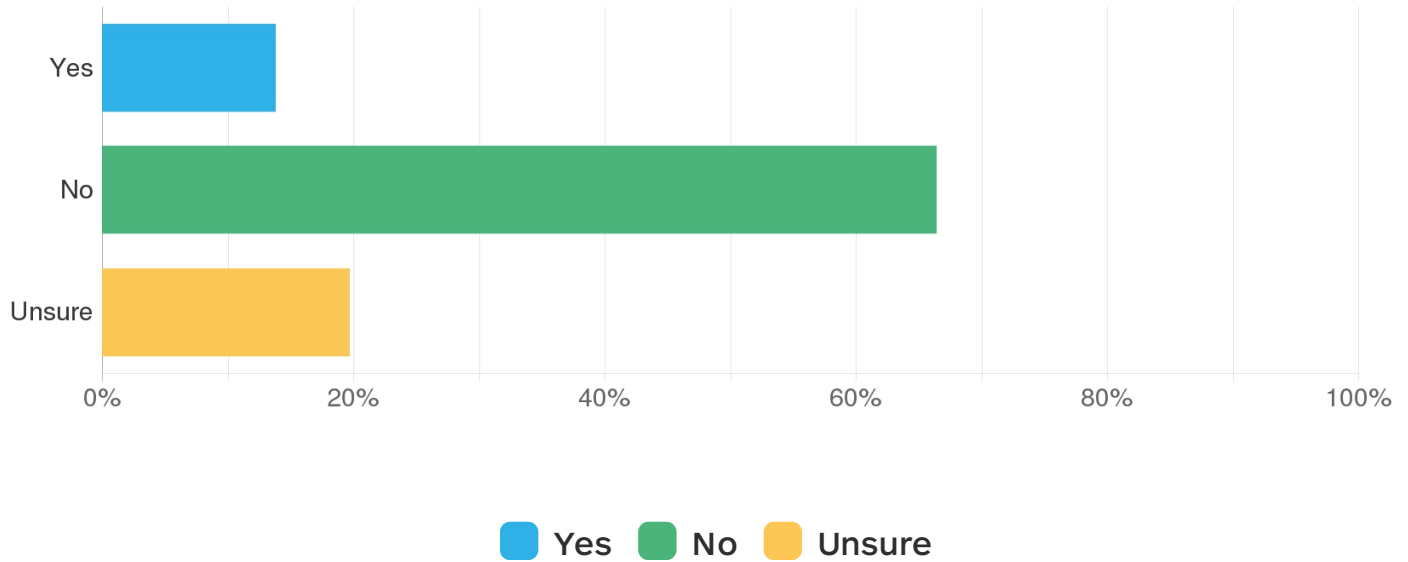

Should boys who say they identify as girls be allowed to compete in women's athletics at the high school or collegiate level?



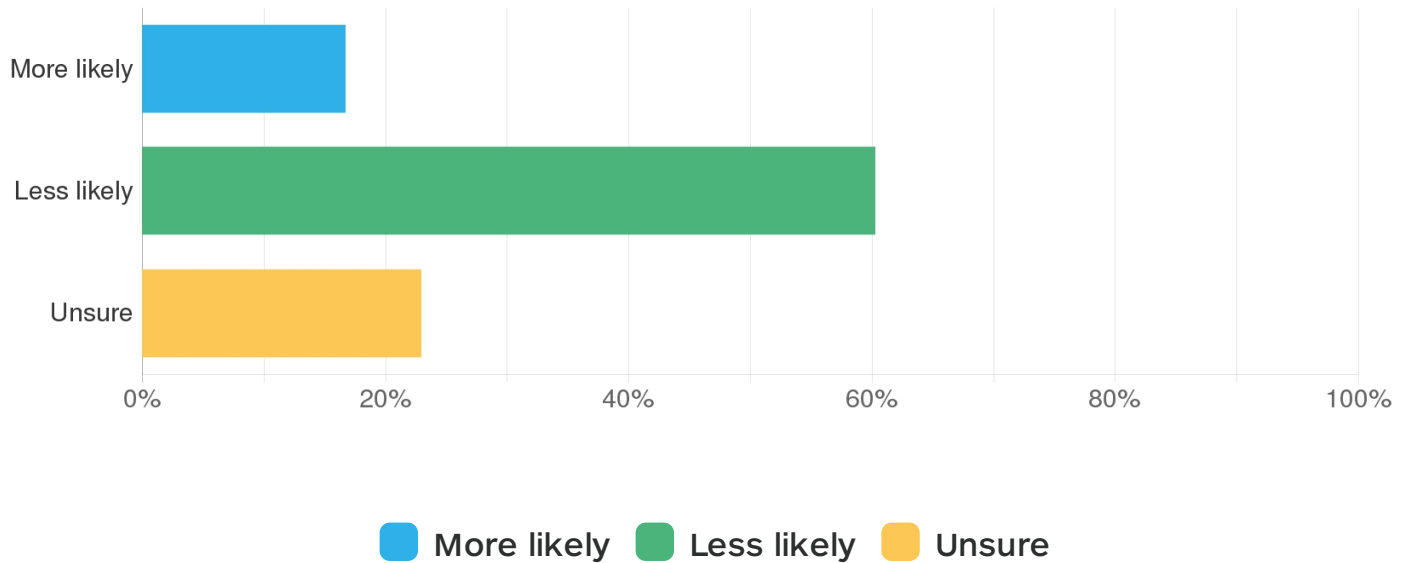

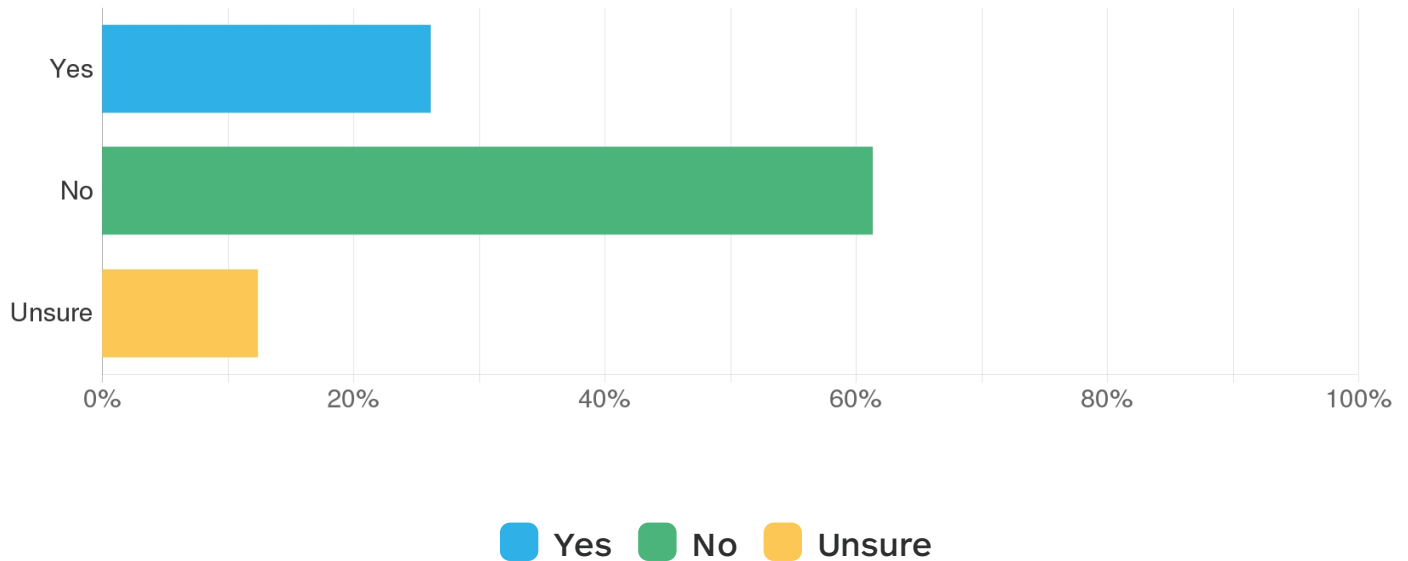

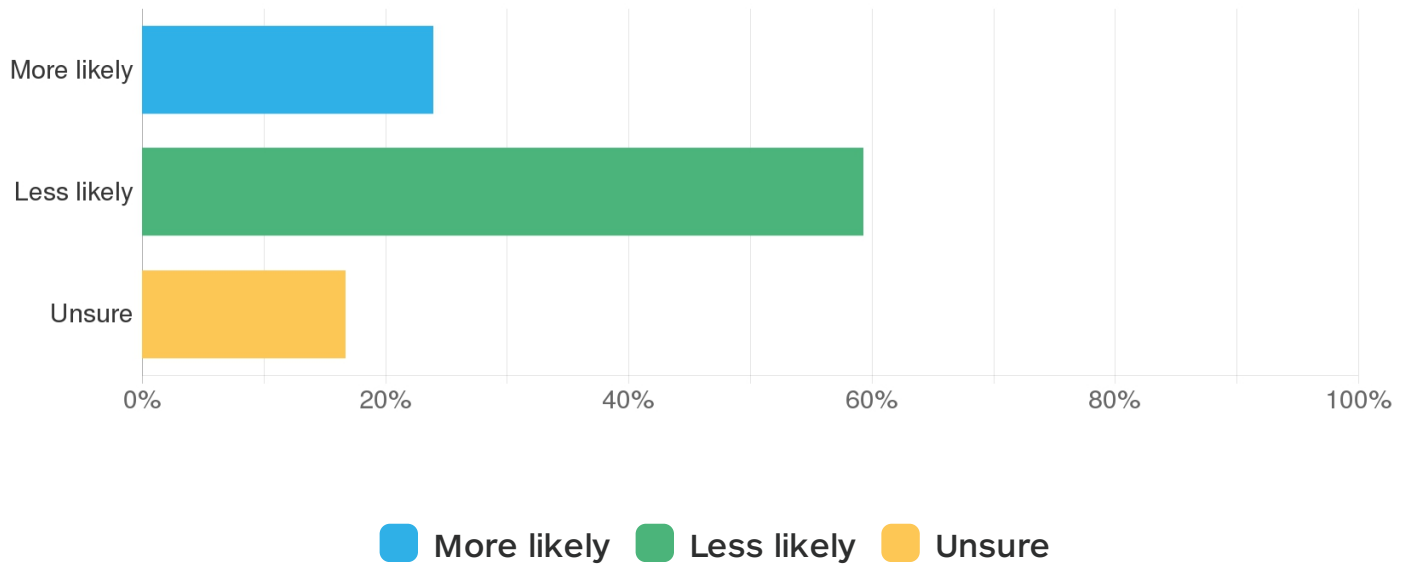

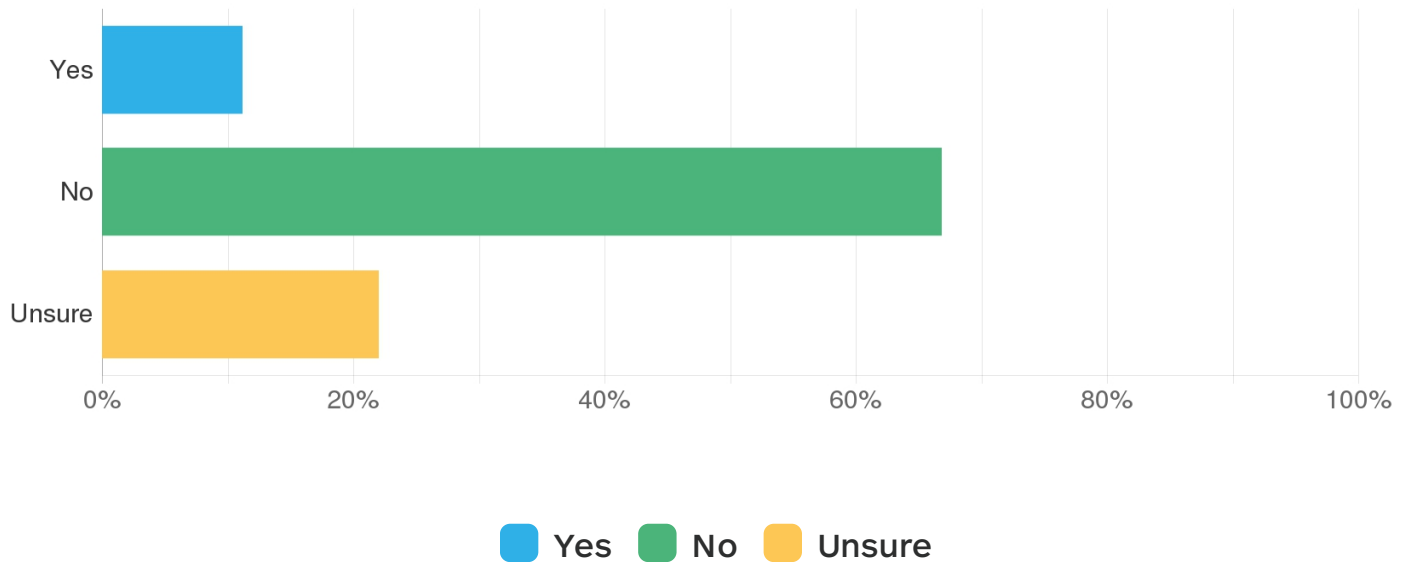

Should male inmates who say they identify as women be allowed to serve their sentence in a women's prison?



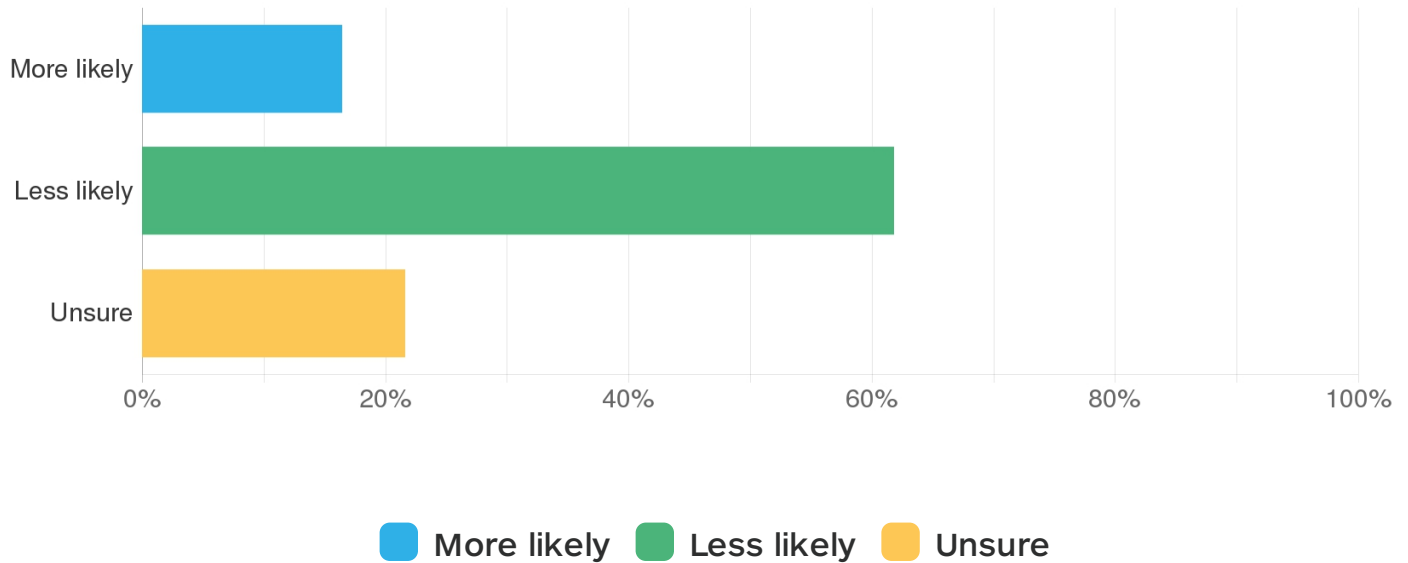

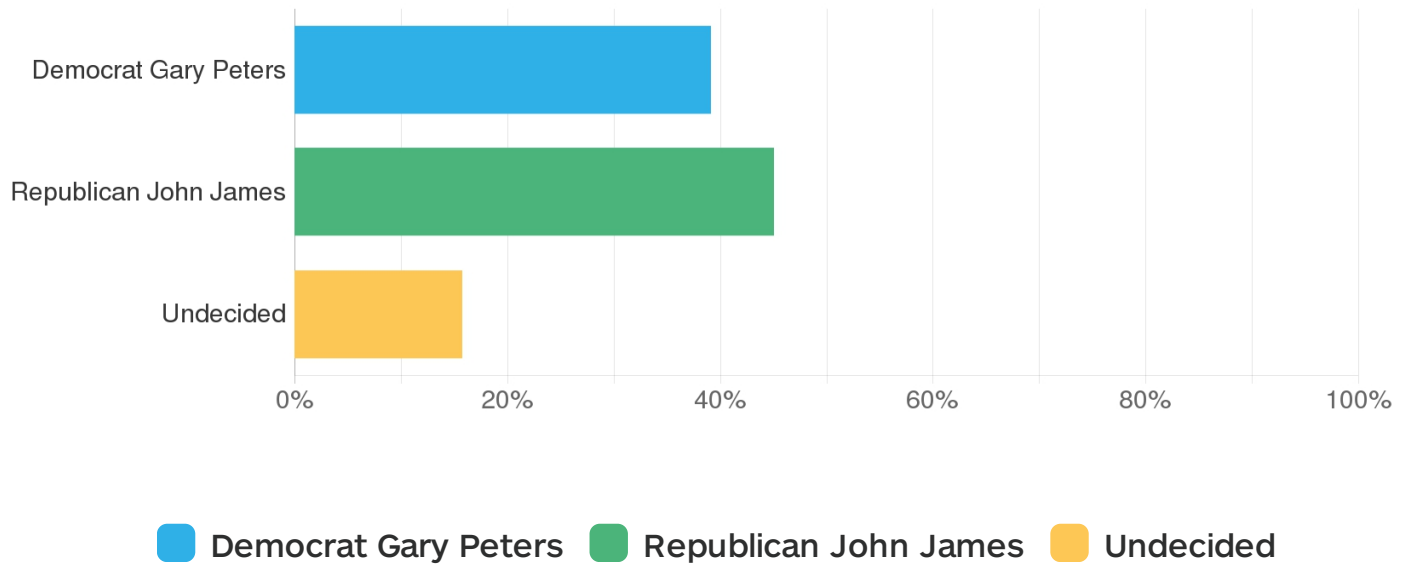

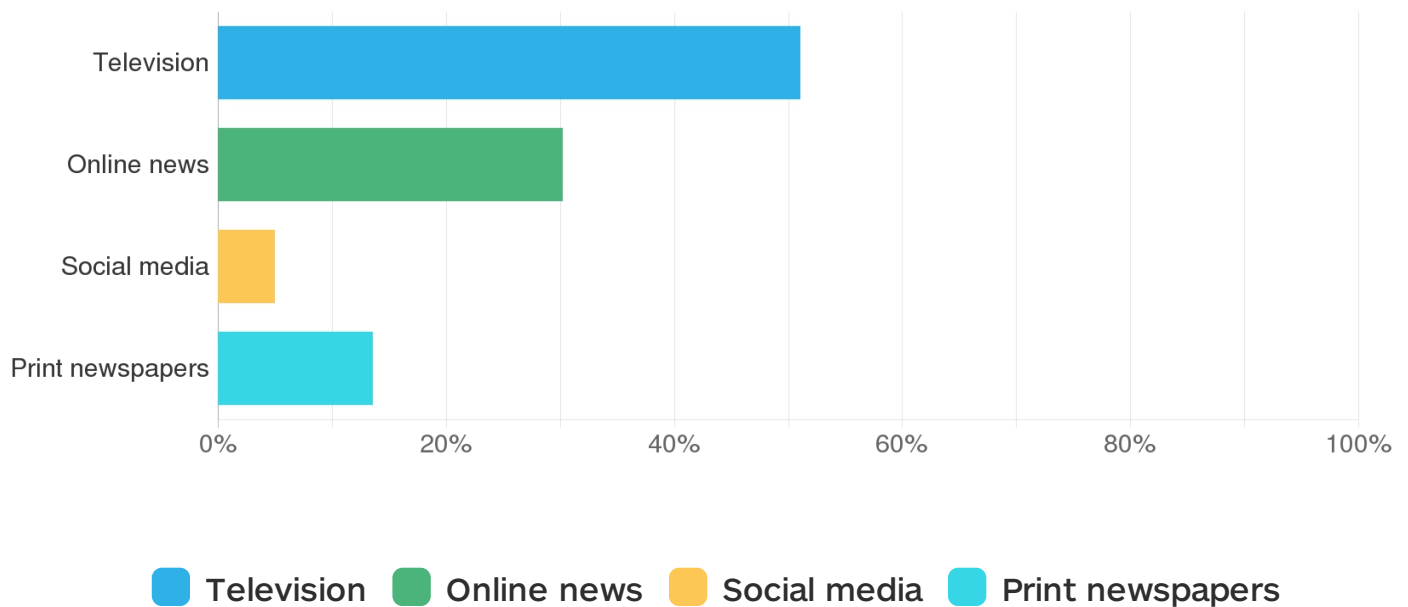

Thinking about how you get your news, which of the following would you say you prefer most for getting news?



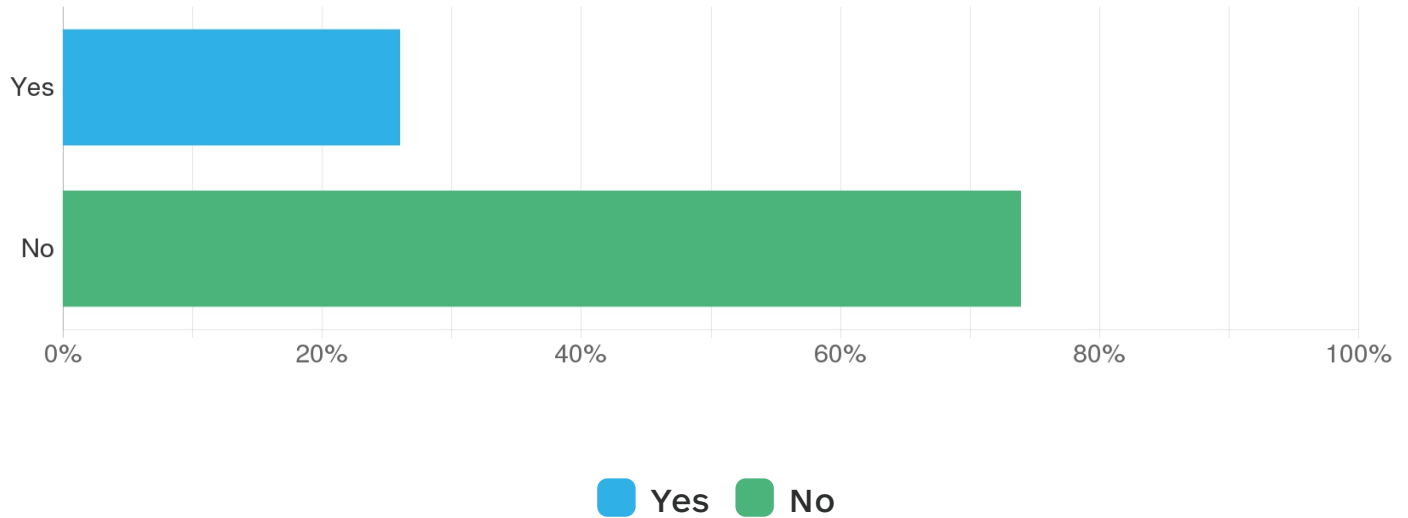

Do you currently have a child or children in K-12 schools in Michigan?



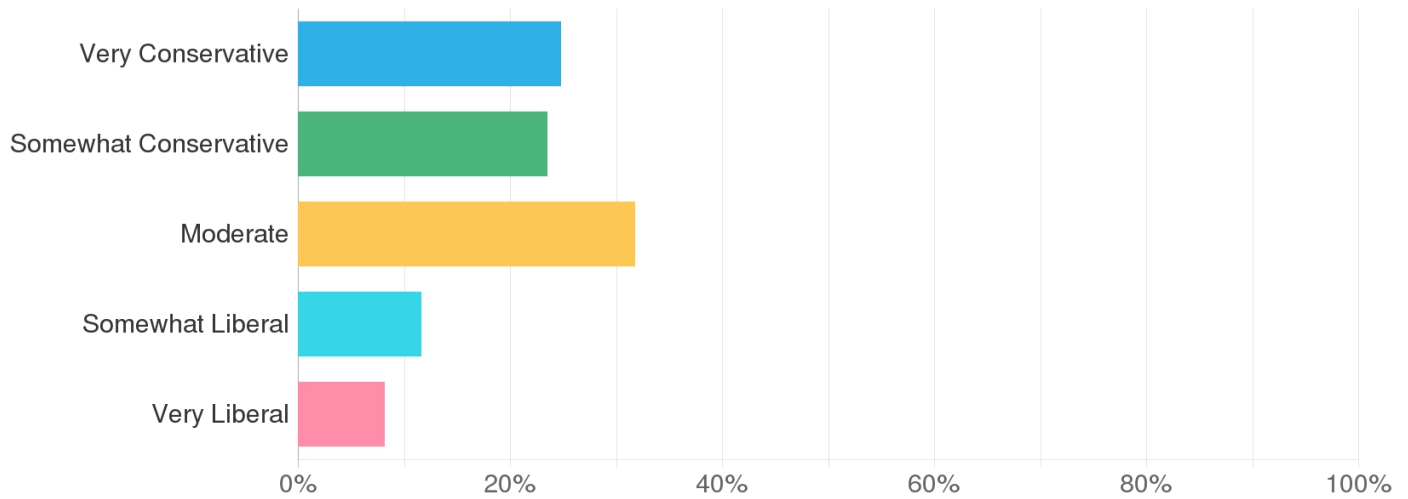

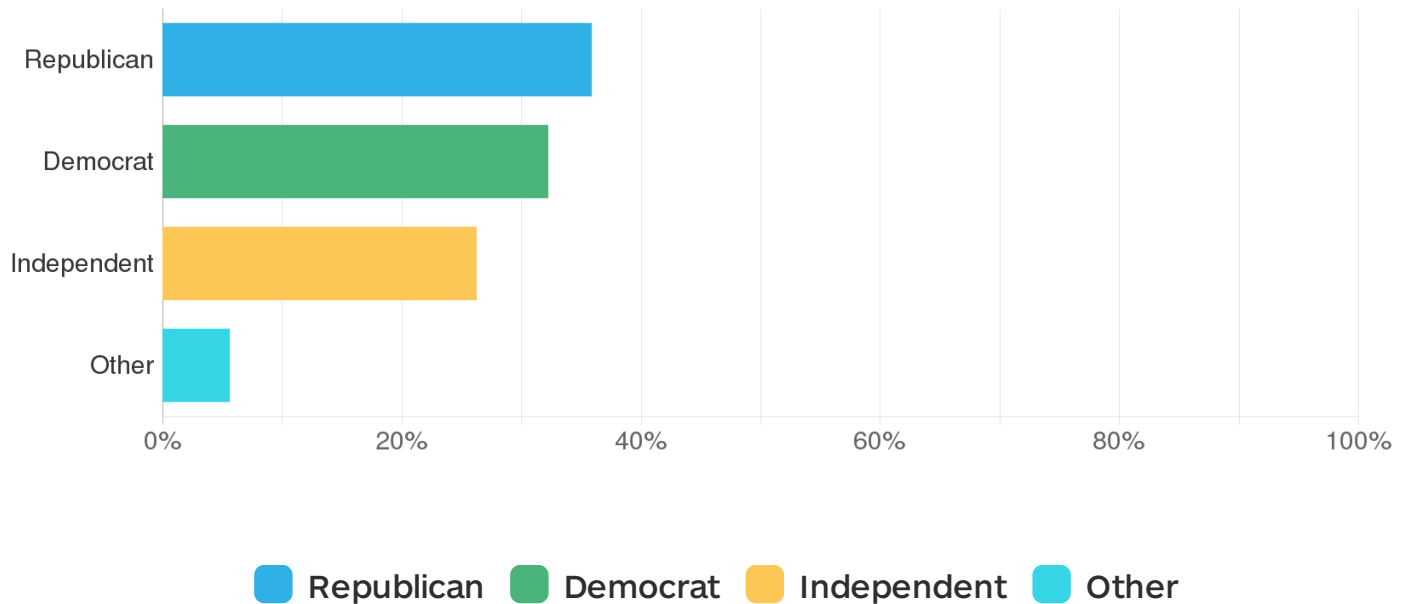

Which of the following best describes your political party?



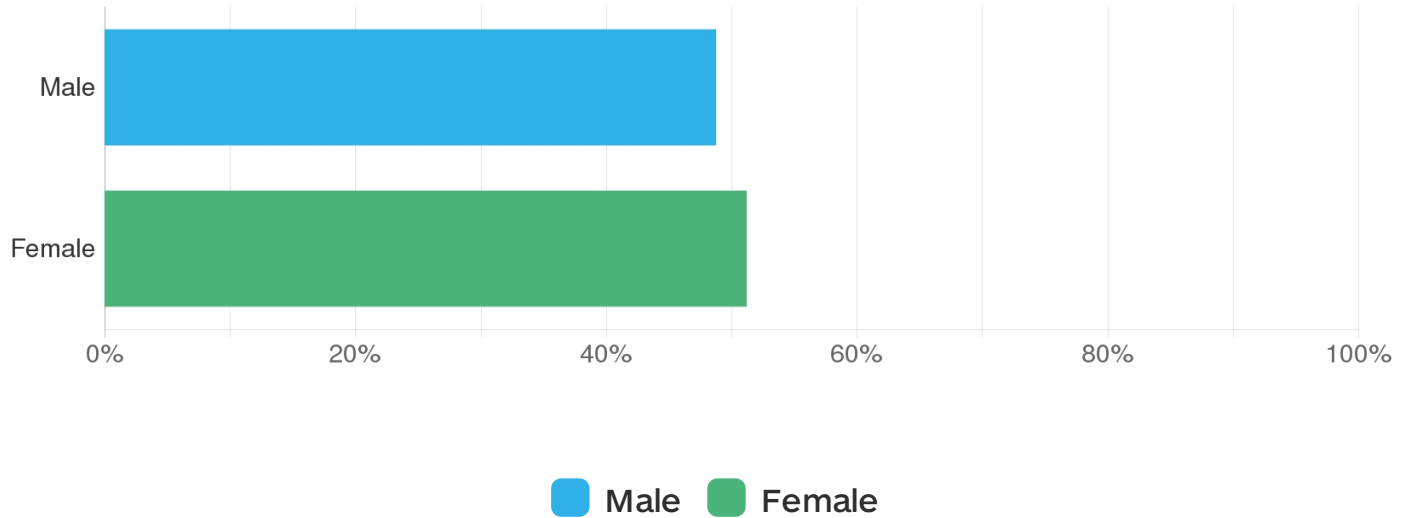

What is your gender?



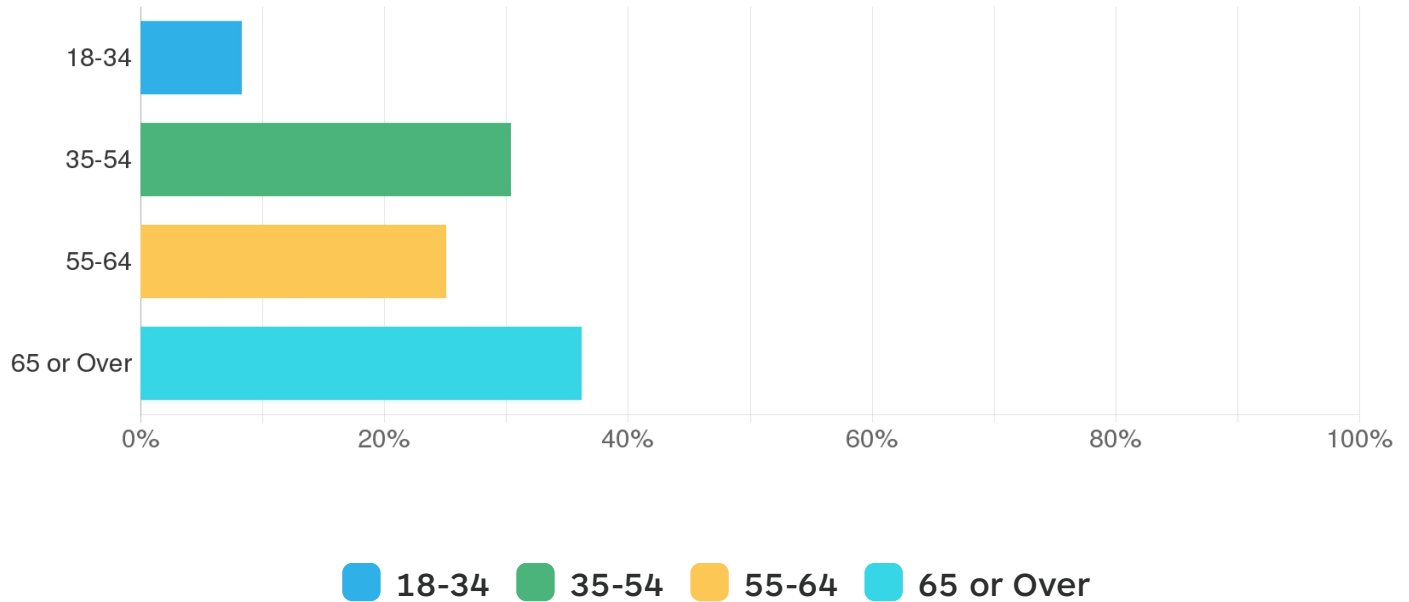
