
#### Methodology


This survey consists of 1,000 likely GOP primary voters and was stratified to reflect historical turnout. The margin of error for this survey is +/- 3.1%.


Thinking about the Republican primary election for President in 2024, would a candidate who prioritizes \_\_\_\_\_\_ be more or less likely to earn your support?





















ENTIRE FIELD PRIMARY BALLOT





ROLE OF GOVERNMENT ON TRANSGENDER ISSUES








