

The survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.0 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.

Q1 : Voter Reg


Are you 18+ and registered to vote? Sample Size: 600

Thinking ahead to the November 5th General Election for President of the United States, how likely are you to vote? Would you say extremely likely, somewhat likely, or not very likely?



Looking back, how would you rate the job Donald Trump did as President? Sample Size: 600








Q6 : Presidential Ballot






































