The APP "Power Five" General Election Survey was conducted by IVR and Online (Online-to-Mobile) Interviews from August 14 - August 20 among a random sample of 600 likely general election voters. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.0 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.





Looking back, how would you rate the job Donald Trump did as President? Sample Size:  $600\,$ 
































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## Q20: Commercialized Gambling





Do you consider yourself to be a Republican, a Democrat, Independent or another party such as Libertarian? Sample Size: 600












